All recipients will be required to provide proof of enrollment into a college or university before the funds will be paid. Funds will be paid directly to the recipient.

TURNER / WILLIAMS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND AWARD

The Turner/Williams Memorial Scholarship Award shall be awarded yearly to selected high school seniors who plan to pursue their education with a major in agriculture or related field and will be awarded to recipients from the local Trust Funds of the Soil and Water Conservation District pursuant to Section 201.001 et. seq. Texas Agricultural Code , D.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each student selected shall meet the following requirements:

1. Student shall be a graduating senior.
2. Student shall have a grade point average that would allow them to be accepted to an accredited university.
3. Student shall have exhibited a continued interest in agriculture throughout his high school career. Outside activities such as 4H or FFA involvement will be considered.
4. Student has exhibited a strong desire to choose a career in an agricultural related field requiring a college degree.
5. Priority shall be given to students who have a financial need for assistance. The appropriate teacher in consultation with the entire selection committee will make this determination.
6. Student shall be a resident of Stephens or Shackelford County at the time of application.

APPLICATION:

Each applicant shall submit a written application and must be in our office no later than **April 16, 2015**. The application shall contain a minimum of grade point average, SAT and/or ACT score, agricultural interests and involvement, financial status, and a narrative of their career goals.
