Endorsements

Under the new paradigm of House Bill 5, students may graduate with not only a diploma. They may also earn a high school endorsement. An endorsement is a formal acknowledgment that a student has completed a rigorous program of studies in a specific discipline. Students may choose from one of thirty Endorsement Focus Plans, each of which satisfies the requirements for one of five endorsement areas:

Arts & Humanities
Business & Industry
Public Service
Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics
(STEM)
Multidisciplinary
