

Buddy R. Dulin & Elizabeth H. Dulin Scholarship Fund

Buddy R. Dulin entered McMurry College in the fall of 1949 upon completing high school as Salutatorian at Colorado City High School. He was the first in a family of ten children to ever go to college, or to even finish high school. Elizabeth H. Dulin entered McMurry College in the fall of 1952, upon completing high school as Valedictorian at Abilene High School. In 1953, Buddy was hired by Albany ISD to teach mathematics and coach. After 12 years, he was named K-8 Principal for Albany ISD and served two years, then was named superintendent of school for seven years. Elizabeth taught for 14 years in Abilene ISD after graduating from Texas University. Buddy R. and Elizabeth H. Dulin had love and concern for children. Although the Dulins had no children of their own, they have “claimed” hundreds as their own through their careers and personal acquaintances. They hope their love will continue through those who receive this scholarship.

Eligibility:

1. Albany ISD graduate
2. Entering or “continuing” degree in Education, Math, or Science.

Scholarship Details:

- Up to two scholarships per year will be awarded
- \$2000 per semester for up to 8 semesters or graduation
- Must provide proof of enrollment in Education, math or Science degree per semester
- Payment will be made directly to the student through Albany ISD Administration Office

Factors to be considered in selection:

- Financial need
- Academic capability
- Persistence to achieve
- Involvement in extracurricular and community activities
- Employment or work history
- Personal qualities including character, motivation, intelligence and maturity
- Quality of written or oral expression

To apply:

1. Submit completed application to Mrs. Riley in Albany High School Office
2. Submit a 3-5 minute video that addresses your eligibility and why you should be awarded the scholarship. Be creative!
